To count for points at Ballarat Regional Centre cross country events during the cross-country season, represent Ballarat at Athletics Victoria cross-country events or score points for the club during track season, you must be a fully registered AV member.

We recommend that all U14 and U16 athletes register with Athletics Victoria, if possible.

Junior athletes (U6 to U12) and U14 and U16 athletes who don't want to register with Athletics Victoria should join via [Revolutionise](#) (scan the QR code below).

Athletics Victoria (AV) winter season

This year Ballarat YCW will again be running as part of the Ballarat combined team in Athletics Victoria championships. Information about how the teams will be organised and selection policy are available on both the Ballarat YCW website (www.ballaratycw.com.au) and the Ballarat Regional Centre Website (www.ballaratregionalaths.com.au).

Club policy information

- Members are encouraged to wear Club uniform on all race days to promote and maintain a high profile for Ballarat YCW around Ballarat.
- Uniform is compulsory in Ballarat Regional Centre and Athletics Victoria events. Current registration numbers must be firmly attached to front and back.
- Singlets and shorts (black for both men and women) can be purchased from the Club. Check with Club officials on a Saturday.
- All perpetual trophies awarded must be returned to the trophy officer at the start of the next winter season. Contact the trophy officer and winter director about free perpetual trophy engraving as soon as possible. Previous winner details can also be engraved.
- The first three place getters in each age division in each of the three Club championships will be awarded gold, silver and bronze Ballarat YCW championship medals.
- The general committee and winter subcommittees of the Club and assisting members will endeavor to select, mark, marshal and officiate courses/events in a safe and appropriate manner to minimise dangers to competitors. However, all athletes compete in Club events at their own risk.
- All Athletics Victoria-registered members automatically have life and personal injury insurance coverage during events (contact AV office). Non AV-registered members are not covered by personal injury insurance and are required to sign a waiver before competing.
- Athletes must have paid their membership fees and as a result be Athletics Victoria registered by the completion of their third event with the Ballarat YCW Athletics Club.

We encourage all YCW Club members, families and friends to stay at the venue after races for afternoon tea and the presentation of trophies. This is an important part of the social life and tradition of the Club and should be supported.



General information for junior members

Cross-country age groups:

U6, U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 (girls and boys).

Age group is determined by age as of the 1st April 2026. Boys and girls generally run together but do not compete against each other (awarded points separately).

The Club endorses a friendly and fun environment with the emphasis on participation, enjoyment and improvement, especially in the younger age groups, which is fostered by the handicap system.

Handicaps:

Most events are handicapped. Handicaps are changed each week, and over the season the handicapper attempts to give all juniors a chance of a win or place. Even the slowest can win. Points are awarded for the handicap finishing order in each race, which count for the aggregate points competition held over the season.

Points for the aggregate:

12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1.

Athlete runs non-handicap event: 3 points.

Athlete goes to Melbourne: receives mid-value of points allocated to people who stay in Ballarat.

For BRAC events (CC Relays, Lap of the Lake, Chas Suffern, Wal Brown 8km) where we run with other clubs, U12, U14 and U16 runners will receive 5 points.

Aggregate points are allocated for a maximum of 20 races.

If an athlete runs more than 20 races, only their 20 best scoring races are counted.

Distances for events:

U6	300m most weeks with some 400m
U8	600m most weeks with some 700m or 800m
U10	1000m or 1200m
U12	1200m or longer runs with U14s
U14–16	normally 3–4km with the shortest 1500m and longest a 6km lap of Lake Wendouree

NOTE: The U6 to U12 age groups run the same distances as summer track season.

Participation:

The Club encourages all U12, U14 and U16 girls and boys to represent YCW and their respective schools in Ballarat Regional Athletic Centre and Athletics Victoria events.

The Club also invites interested parents to assist in the conduct of junior events – from marshalling a corner to helping to collect race tags and course flags.

Trophies:

Trophies are awarded for first, second and third place-getters in the girls and boys age-group aggregates at the end of the season. Anyone who runs most of the weekly races has a real chance to win their age group. Numerous trophies are awarded and held for 12 months, for special handicap races and fastest time recorded.

Club Championship races:

There are three Club Championship races during the season with gold, silver and bronze medals awarded to place-getters in each race.

Ballarat Cross-Country Championships:

U14 and U16 athletes are encouraged to represent their club in the five Ballarat Cross-Country Championships against other juniors from Ballarat clubs, provided they are registered with Athletics Victoria. There are also four races for U12 athletes (1500m or 2000m) at each of the Ballarat Regional Centre events.

Athletics Victoria Championship races:

Athletes can gain state-level experience by participating in AV Championship races.

Victorian School Cross Country Championships:

YCW juniors get the chance to compete for their school rather than club in these events.

Senior aggregate scoring

- 8 points** for competing in Athletics Victoria events where a club handicap is held on the same day.
- 5 points** for competing in Athletics Victoria events where there is no club handicap on the same day.
- 5 points** for competing in Ballarat Centre events.
- 3 points** for competing in Club events.

Aggregate points are only applied to Club handicaps and sealed handicaps. It is possible to gain points twice in one weekend if you compete in both a Club handicap and an AV event. This occurs on a few occasions this season and participation must be rewarded.

Points in order of finish: 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1

Ethel Brown, mother of Wal, was the driving force behind the ladies' committee from its beginning in 1949. She was the inaugural president, a position she held for decades until her sudden death in January 1975. 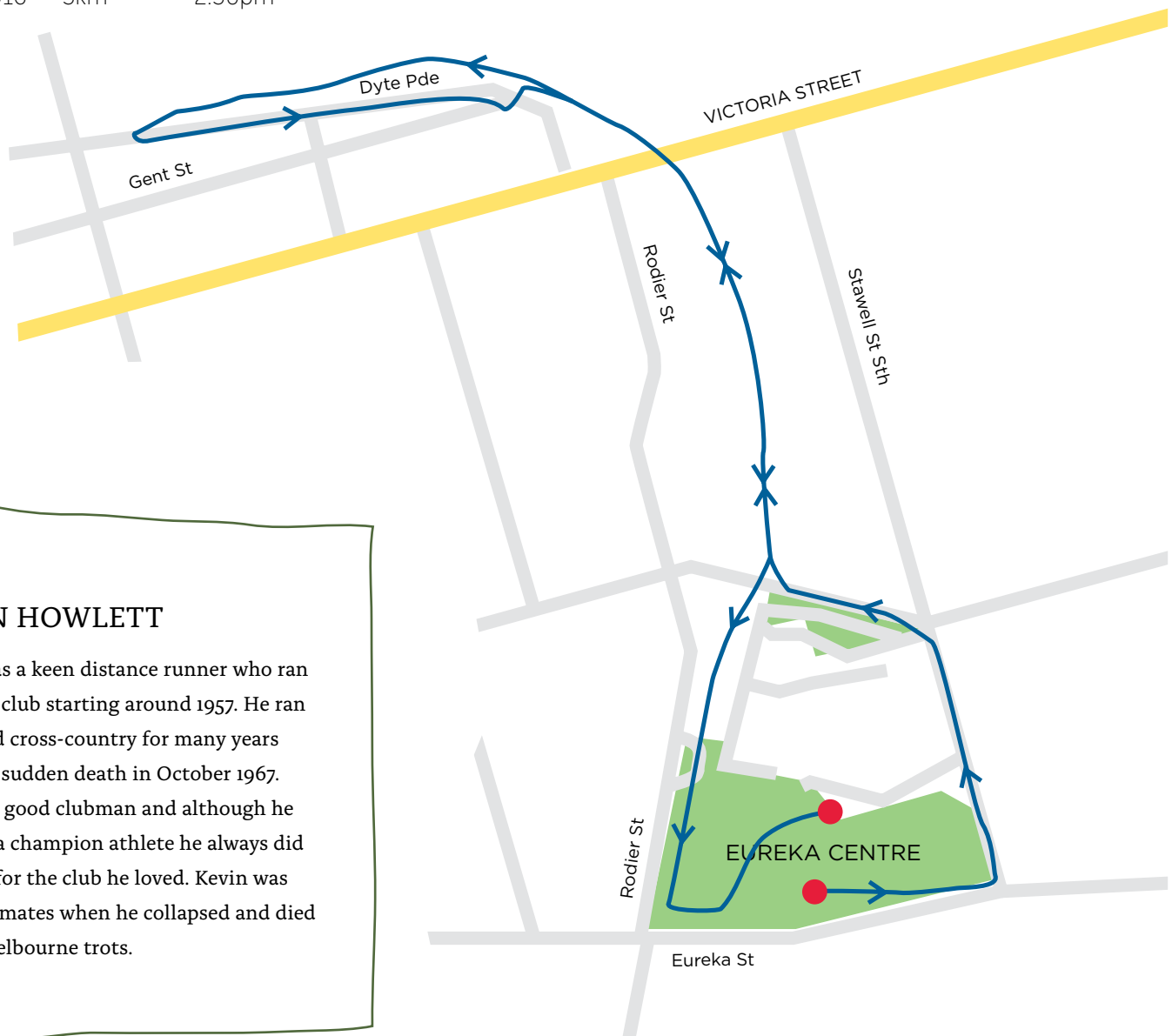

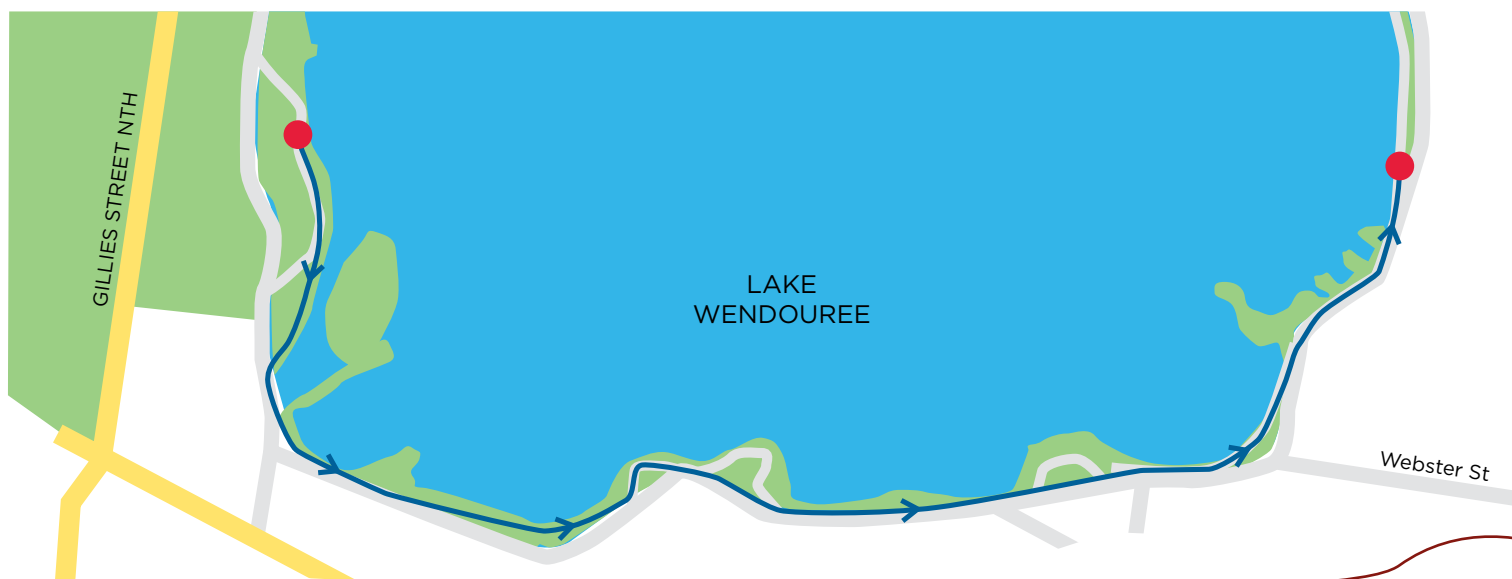

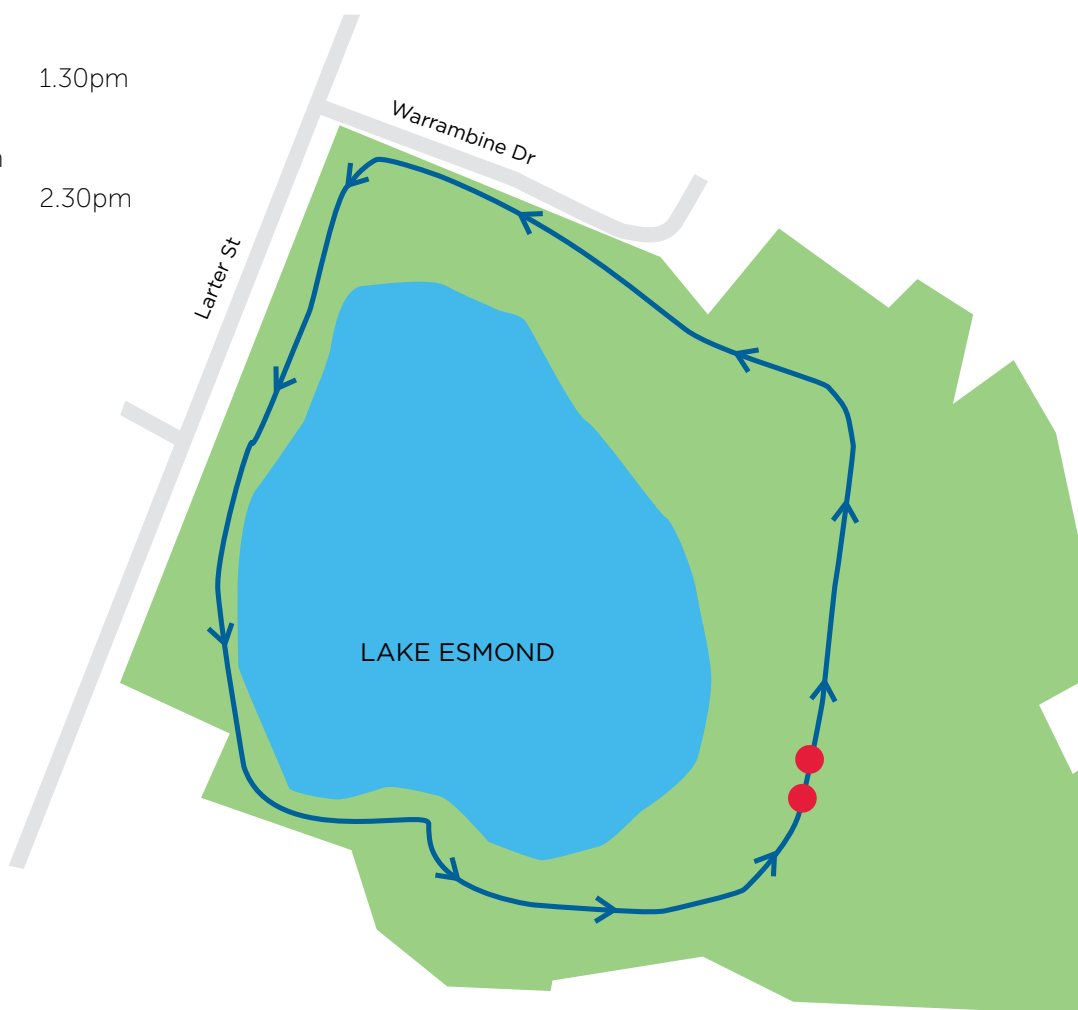

TOM CONROY

Tom Conroy is an indelible name in the history of YCW as an athlete, administrator, veteran club and regional centre handicapper, and last remaining link between YCW Harriers and its predecessor CYMS Harriers. Tom first became involved in athletics in the late 1930s with CYMS. With the formation of YCW Harriers in 1946, Tom renewed his association with athletics and became a valued member of the first committee. During those formative years, Tom guided, encouraged and urged the athletes in their early challenges. Although most of the members who helped establish the club were not around to see it reach maturity, Tom was still there! The job that he is remembered most for is handicapper, a position he performed for decades.

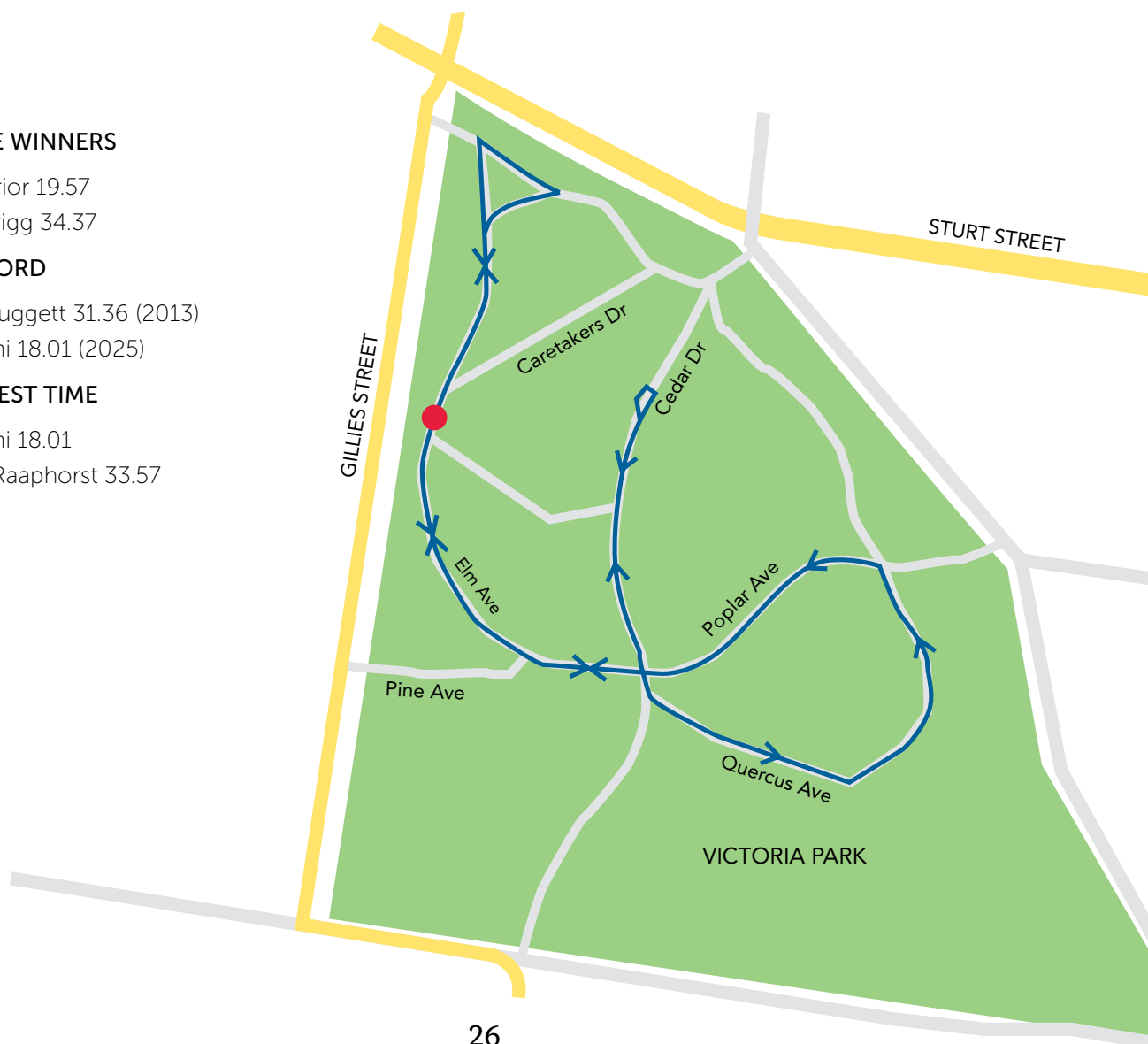

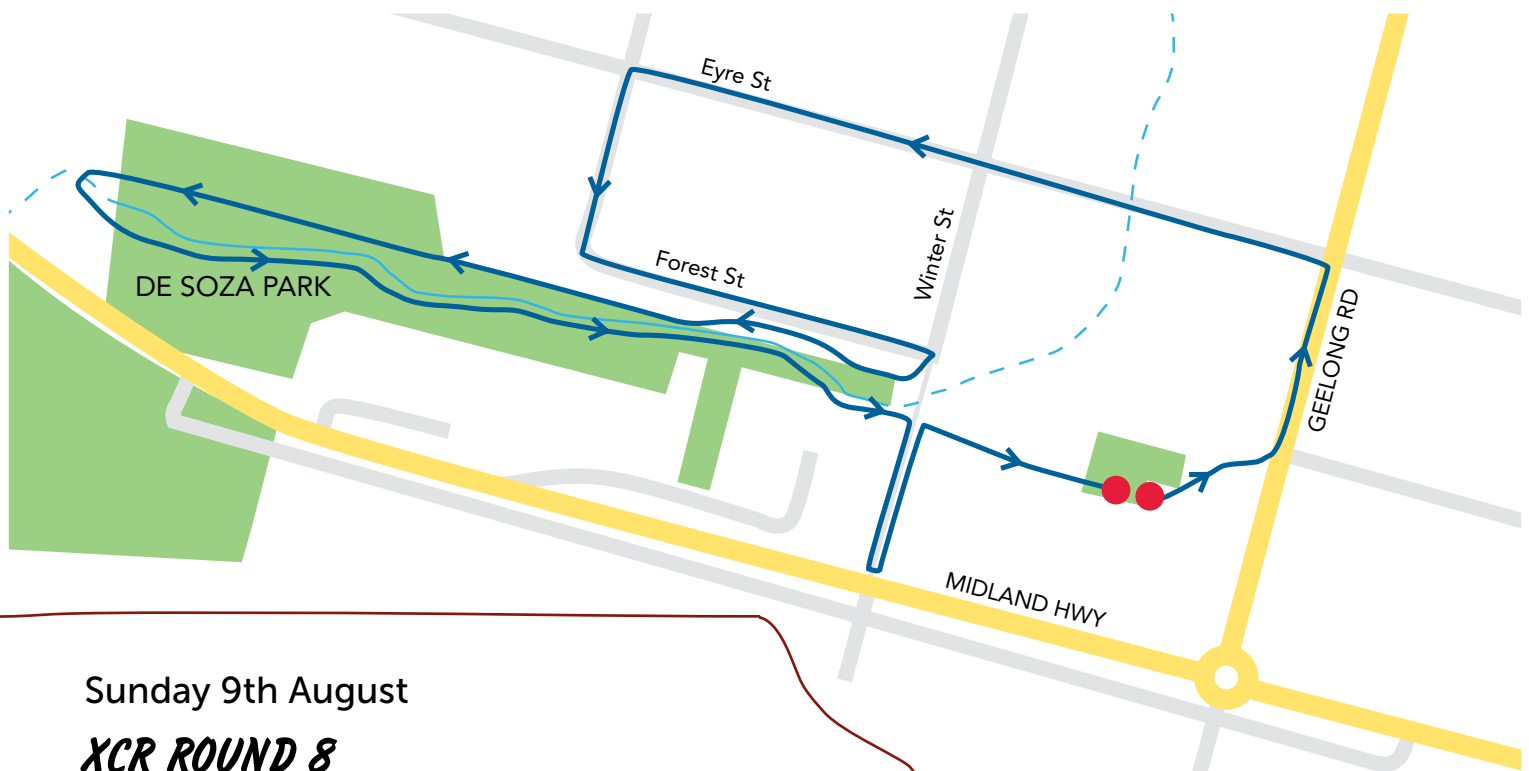

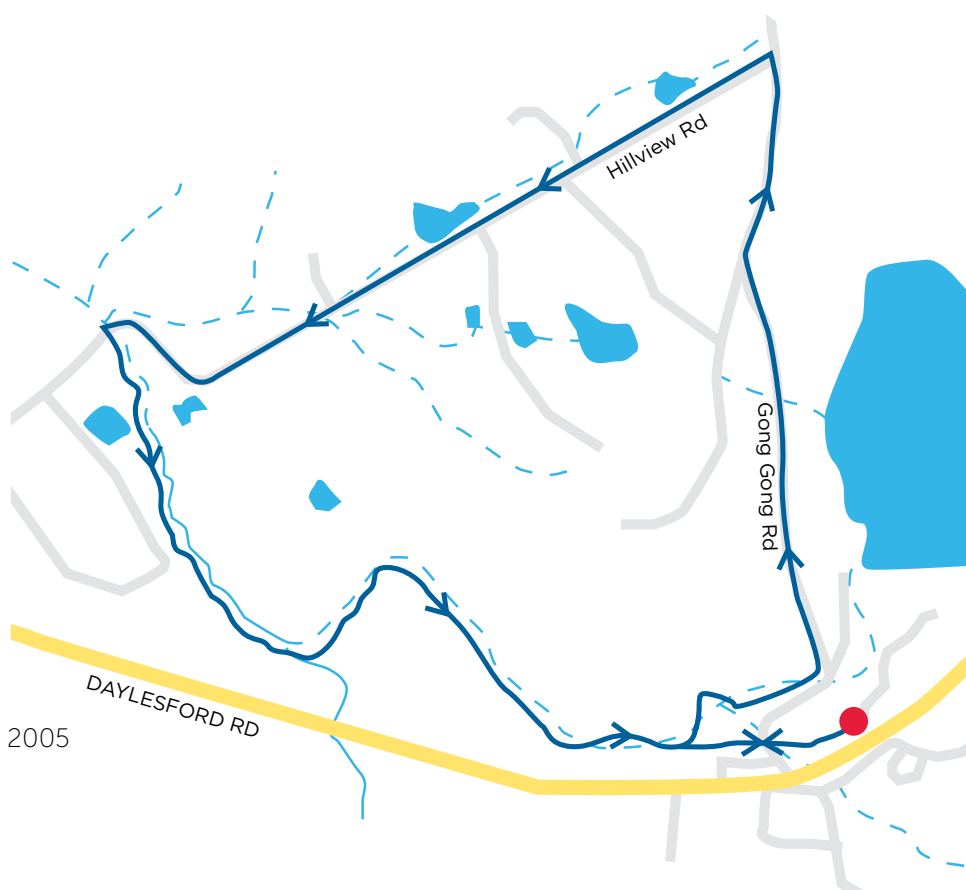
